

RESOLUTION NO 1071

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES REJECTING THE BID OF COASTSIDE CONCRETE OF SANTA ROSA, CA, FOR ADMINISTRATION DRIVE SEWER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, AWARDING CONTRACT NO. C00474 TO TEAM GHILOTTI, INC. OF PETALUMA, CA, AND RATIFYING THE STREAMBED ALTERATION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, bids have been invited for the performance of work for the City of Santa Rosa, generally described as Administration Drive Sewer Improvements, Contract No. C00474; and

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened in accordance with law and the City Engineer as reported thereon; and

WHEREAS, Coastside Concrete of Santa Rosa, CA, submitted a non-responsive bid for the failure to identify the completion of work of similar character and scope to the proposed project and the failure to list a subcontractor which are requirements in the Invitation for Bids; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bidder, Team Ghilotti, Inc. of Petaluma, CA, submitted a responsive bid that complies with the requirements in the Invitation for Bids; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Utilities has considered the report of the City Engineer and has concluded that Coastside Concrete of Santa Rosa, CA, has submitted a non-responsive bid and that Team Ghilotti, Inc., of Petaluma, CA, is the lowest responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Public Utilities (Board) rejects the bid of Coastside Concrete of Santa Rosa, CA as non-responsive.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board awards Contract No. C00474 to Team Ghilotti, Inc. of Petaluma, CA, in the amount of \$821,768.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board approves, in accordance with City Council Policy No. 100-07, "Authorization of Contract Change Orders on Public Works Contracts," a total authorized contract amount of \$945,033.20 (the original contract amount plus a 15% contingency).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board authorizes the Finance Director to pay all proper claims for performance of the contract out of JL Key 70634, "North Trunk Sewer Relocation."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board ratifies the Streambed Alteration Agreement issued by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife as signed by the Director of Utilities or his designee.
