

RESOLUTION NO. 1052

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES RECOMMENDING THAT THE SANTA ROSA CITY COUNCIL ADOPT AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 14-04 (POTABLE WATER AND RECYCLED WATER SERVICE) OF THE SANTA ROSA CITY CODE TO DEFINE INTERRUPTIBLE RECYCLED WATER CUSTOMER AND TO ADD PROVISIONS FOR RECYCLED WATER RATES FOR CURRENT INTERRUPTIBLE RECYCLED WATER CUSTOMERS

WHEREAS, the Santa Rosa Subregional Water Reclamation System (Subregional System) provides tertiary treated recycled water to agricultural and urban irrigation users; and

WHEREAS, the Subregional System wholesales recycled water to the Santa Rosa water utility, which serves the Santa Rosa Urban Reuse System; and

WHEREAS, in July 2013, the City Council set a wholesale recycled water rate for interruptible service; and

WHEREAS, certain retail recycled water customers store recycled water on their property site and use the stored recycled water to pressurize their irrigation system. As such, these sites can have their service interrupted at any time and provide flexibility to the Subregional System; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of this flexibility, the wholesale recycled water rate for interruptible service should be extended to these retail recycled water customers; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Ordinance adds language to the City Code defining an interruptible recycled water customer; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Ordinance also adds provisions for extending the wholesale recycled water rate for interruptible service to the interruptible recycled water customers.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Public Utilities recommends that the Santa Rosa City Council adopt an ordinance amending certain sections of Chapter 14-04 (Potable Water and Recycled Water Service) of the Santa Rosa City Code to define interruptible recycled water customer and to add provisions for recycled water rates for current interruptible recycled water customers.


