

RESOLUTION NO. 1013

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA
REDUCING MONTHLY FIRE LINE PROTECTION FEE AND ESTABLISHING MONTHLY
FIRE LINE PROTECTION BACKFLOW PREVENTION DEVICE TEST FEE

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Utilities has determined that the Utilities Department should charge the individual user for services required in connection with specific user-related services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Utilities has determined that Monthly Fire Line Protection Fee should be reduced by five dollars and a new Monthly Fire Line Protection Backflow Prevention Device Test Fee should be established for those utility accounts with backflow prevention devices which will continue to be tested by City staff; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that, effective January 3, 2012, the Board of Public Utilities reduces the monthly Fire Line Protection Fee as follows:

<i>Monthly Fire Line Protection Fee</i>	<i>Existing fee</i>	<i>New fee</i>
- 2"	\$23	\$18
- 4"	\$23	\$18
- 6"	\$28	\$23
- 8"	\$38	\$33
-10"	\$43	\$38

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that effective January 3, 2012, the Board of Public Utilities establishes a new Monthly Fire Line Protection Backflow Testing Fee of five dollars, for those utility accounts with backflow prevention devices which will continue to be tested by City staff, as follows:

<i>Monthly Fire Line Protection Backflow Testing Fee</i>	\$5
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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board finds that the new fees and charges approved in this resolution are for the purposes of meeting operating expenses and, accordingly, the Board finds this resolution exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act under section 21080(b) and State CEQA Guidelines section 15273(a). The Board further finds that the fees and charges adopted by this resolution are not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act under the provisions of State CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3) in that the Board finds that there is no possibility such new or increased fees and charges will have a significant effect on the environment.






