

RESOLUTION NO. 967

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES RECOMMENDING THAT THE SANTA ROSA CITY COUNCIL ADOPT AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 14-04 (POTABLE WATER AND RECYCLED WATER SERVICE) OF THE SANTA ROSA CITY CODE TO ADD PROVISIONS FOR RECYCLED WATER RATES FOR USERS SERVED BY INTERRUPTIBLE SUPPLY

WHEREAS, in September 2007, the City Council adopted the Santa Rosa Urban Recycled Water Ordinance which established conditions and authorities relative to the use of recycled water within the Santa Rosa Urban Growth Boundary; and

WHEREAS, in November 2007, the City Council set recycled water rates that went into effect on October 1, 2008, and

WHEREAS, certain recycled water customers served by an extension of the City's agricultural recycled system will have interruptible supply until the new recycled water system is extended to provide them with non-interruptible supply; and

WHEREAS, a provision can be added to the City Code to establish that recycled water users on interruptible supply continue to have rates set by contract until more reliable supply is available to them; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Ordinance adds language which stipulates that customers served by interruptible recycled water supply will continue to have rates determined by contract until non-interruptible supply is available.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Public Utilities recommends that the Santa Rosa City Council adopt an ordinance amending certain sections of Chapter 14-04 (Potable Water and Recycled Water Service) of the Santa Rosa City Code to establish provisions for recycled water rates for customers served by interruptible recycled water supply.
