

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES RECOMMENDING APPROVAL BY CITY COUNCIL OF THE FINAL SANITARY SEWER MANAGEMENT PLAN AS REQUIRED BY THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD ORDER NO. 2006-0003-STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDR) FOR SANITARY SEWER SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2006, the State Water Resources Control Board Order No. 2006-0003- Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems (WDR) was adopted and implemented; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the WDR is to develop a regulatory mechanism to provide a consistent statewide approach for reducing sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs); and

WHEREAS, the WDR requires preparation of a Sanitary Sewer Management Plan (SSMP) with 11 separate elements; and


WHEREAS, the SSMP is now complete and must be approved by City Council prior to online certification of completion on the California Integrated Water Quality System database.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Public Utilities recommends to the City Council that it approve the final SSMP as required by the State Water Resources Control Board Order No. 2006-0003-Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) for Sanitary Sewer Systems.


