

RESOLUTION NO. 925

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA RELIEVING TEAM GHILOTTI, INC. OF PETALUMA, CA, OF ITS BID AND AWARDING CONTRACT NO. 08-805 TO ARGONAUT CONSTRUCTORS OF SANTA ROSA, CA, FOR TODD ROAD TRUNK SEWER

WHEREAS, bids have been invited for the performance of work for the City of Santa Rosa, generally described as Todd Road Trunk Sewer, Contract Number 08-805; and

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened in accordance with law and the City Engineer has reported thereon; and

WHEREAS, the lowest bidder, Team Ghilotti, Inc. of Petaluma, CA, has formally requested to be relieved of their bid due to a clerical error in their bid;

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Utilities has considered the report of the City Engineer and has concluded that Team Ghilotti, Inc. of Petaluma, CA made a clerical error in their bid and that the bid of Argonaut Constructors of Santa Rosa, CA, was the second lowest responsive bid received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Public Utilities relieves Team Ghilotti, Inc. of Petaluma, CA, of its bid as requested by Team Ghilotti, Inc. of Petaluma, CA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Public Utilities accepts the bid of Argonaut Constructors of Santa Rosa, CA, in the amount of \$2,871,323.00 and awards Contract Number 08-805 to Argonaut Constructors of Santa Rosa, CA, in the amount of \$2,871,323.00 and for performance in accordance with plans and specifications on file in the Office of the City Engineer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Public Utilities authorizes and directs the Chair to execute the contract and the Director of Administrative Services to pay all proper claims for performance of the contract out of Account No. 7952, "Todd Road Trunk Sewer".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in accordance with City Council Policy No. 100-07, "Authorization of Contract Change Orders on Public Works Contracts," the Board of Public Utilities approves a total authorized contract amount of \$3,302,021.45 (the original contract amount plus a 15% contingency).
