

RESOLUTION NO. 916

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA
ADOPTING MISCELLANEOUS FEES AND CHARGES

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Utilities has determined that changes are required to the schedule of miscellaneous fees and charges in order that the customer receiving the particular service or causing the incurrence of utility cost or expense will pay the cost thereof and shall be adopted with certain modifications as recommended and justified by staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Public Utilities of the City of Santa Rosa adopts and authorizes and directs the Director of Utilities/City Engineer to charge and collect, on and after March 17, 2008, the following fees and charges for the services and occurrences specified:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Public Utilities, that all prior resolutions of the Board respecting the adoption of fees and charges for those occurrences set forth in this resolution shall be without further effect as to any such services rendered or occurrences taking place, on and after March 17, 2008.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board finds that the new and increased fees and charges approved in this resolution are for the purposes of meeting operating expenses and, accordingly, the Board finds this resolution exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act under section 21080(b) and State CEQA Guidelines section 15273(a). The Board further finds that the fees and charges adopted by this resolution are not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act under the provisions of State CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3) in that the Board finds that there is no possibility such new or increased fees and charges will have a significant effect on the environment.
