

RESOLUTION NO. 905

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES RECOMMENDING THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA REVISE THE CHARGES AND RATES FOR POTABLE WATER SERVICES AND ESTABLISH CHARGES AND RATES FOR RECYCLED WATER SERVICES

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City that the water system facilities be operated as a self-supporting utility and that service charges for its use shall be calculated and changed from time to time in sufficient amounts to operate and maintain the system to meet the needs of all users; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Utilities has considered the report and recommendations of the Utilities and Administrative Services Departments on increasing potable water service charges and rates and establishing recycled water service charges and rates; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Utilities finds that the potable and recycled water rate increases set forth herein are for the purpose of meeting operating expenses, cost of supplies, materials and equipment, and financing capital projects necessary to maintain service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Public Utilities recommends that the City Council pass an Ordinance to amend code sections 14-04.090 and 14-08.010 to revise potable water service charges and quantity rates, establish recycled water service charges and quantity rates on October 1, 2008, and revise recycled water service charges and quantity rates on January 1, 2009 as shown in the attached Exhibit.
