

RESOLUTION NO. 909

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES RECOMMENDING THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA ADOPT THE RECYCLED WATER STANDARDS

WHEREAS, Santa Rosa's water supply plans and wastewater disposal plans both anticipate an expanded role for urban recycled water use in landscape irrigation and for other approved uses; and

WHEREAS, Santa Rosa has the authority to require new connections to the water system to use recycled water for eligible uses per City Council adopted Ordinance No. 3845; and

WHEREAS, Santa Rosa periodically adopts and publishes standards for the design and construction of City infrastructure, including the potable water system; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Recycled Water Standards would establish the standards for how the recycled water system and system components should be designed and constructed; and

WHEREAS, many of the standards for the potable water system are also appropriate for the design and construction of the recycled water system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Rosa Utilities Department has developed recycled water standards, incorporating potable water system standards as appropriate, in conjunction with local contractors and their organizations, and local design professionals and their organizations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Public Utilities that recommends that the City Council, by resolution, adopt the Recycled Water Standards.
