

RESOLUTION NO. 874

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES RECOMMENDING THAT THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA CITY COUNCIL ADOPT THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL LANDSCAPE POLICY

WHEREAS, the Santa Rosa General Plan sets forth policies which promote the conservation and efficient use of water to prevent the waste of this valuable resource; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Single Family Residential Landscape Policy is consistent with and would further the goals of the General Plan by providing regulations that promote residential landscape designs, installation and maintenance that is water efficient and water conserving; and

WHEREAS, the proposed policy has been presented by City staff and reviewed by this Board; and

WHEREAS, the same proposed policy was reviewed and recommended for adoption by the Water Conservation Subcommittee of this Board; and

WHEREAS, this Board adopted Resolution No. 872 on September 21, 2006 recommending that the City Council adopt the same proposed policy; and

WHEREAS, the proposed policy before the Board on September 21, 2006 did not include the full text of Appendix A of the proposed policy; and

WHEREAS, the Board has now reviewed the proposed City of Santa Rosa Single Family Residential Landscape Policy, including the full text of Appendix A; and

WHEREAS, this resolution replaces and supersedes Resolution No. 872 adopted by this Board on September 21, 2006.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Public Utilities, by resolution, recommends that the City Council adopt the City of Santa Rosa Single Family Residential Landscape Policy.
