RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA
ADDING MISCELLANEOUS FEES AND CHARGES FOR SANITARY SEWER LATERAL
CONNECTION INSPECTION FEES, WATER EFFICIENT LANDSCAPE POLICY (WELP)
REVIEW FEES, WATER SUPPLY ASSESSMENT (WSA) FEES AND WATER SUPPLY
VERIFICATION (WSV) FEES

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Utilities has determined that The Utilities Department should charge the individual user for services required in connection with specific user related procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Utilities has reviewed proposed new fees for Sanitary Sewer Lateral Connection Inspection Fees, Water Efficient Landscape Policy (WELP) Review Fees, Water Supply Assessment (WSA) Fees And Water Supply Verification (WSV) Fees and found the fees necessary and reasonable,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Public Utilities of the City of Santa Rosa adds the following fees to the Schedule of Miscellaneous Fees and Charges and authorizes and directs the Director of Utilities/City Engineer to charge and collect, on and after July 1, 2006, said fees and charges for the services and occurrences specified:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Public Utilities, that prior Resolution 800 of the Board regarding the adoption of existing miscellaneous fees and charges and shall remain in effect for all services described therein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board finds that the new fees and charges approved in this resolution are for the purposes of meeting operating expenses and, accordingly, the Board finds this resolution exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act under section 21080(b) and State CEQA Guidelines section 15273(a). The Board further finds

that the fees and charges adopted by this resolution are not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act under the provisions of State CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3) in that the Board finds that there is no possibility such new or increased fees and charges will have a significant effect on the environment.
