

RESOLUTION NO. 766

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES AUTHORIZING FUNDING FOR THE LAGUNA VEGETATION MANAGEMENT TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, the Laguna de Santa Rosa is an important resource in our community; and

WHEREAS, an interagency task force began meeting in January, 2003 to address problems posed by exotic invasive plant species in the Laguna; and

WHEREAS, the current manifestation of the exotic, invasive species is Ludwigia Peplodes; and

WHEREAS, the task force is seeking funding to study the spread of invasive species in the Laguna;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Public Utilities authorizes funding for the Laguna Vegetation Management Task Force in the amount of \$20,000 per year for fiscal years 2003-2004 and 2004-2005, (the 2004-2005 approval is contingent upon budget approval in 2004-2005). The source of funds being 1384-21.
