

## RESOLUTION NO.770

### RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA APPROVING A REVISED GUIDE TO WATER AND WASTEWATER POLICY

WHEREAS, in December 1995, the Board of Public Utilities adopted a draft Guide to Water and Wastewater Policy to provide guidance and assistance to the public and to staff; and

WHEREAS, in November 2000, the Board of Public Utilities adopted a revised Guide to Water and Wastewater Policy to reflect simplify and clarify the policies and procedures in the Guide; and

WHEREAS, additional experience has been gained in the implementation of policies and procedures in the Guide, resulting in staff recommendations to further simplify and clarify its provisions; and

WHEREAS, Utilities staff will soon be notifying non-residential property owners of the water demand allocation for their properties, allocations of which they are not currently aware and which they may soon exceed by some change in their operations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Utilities has considered the staff recommendations for revisions to the Guide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Public Utilities of the City of Santa Rosa approves the revised Guide to Water and Wastewater Policy dated October 2003 as set forth.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that non-residential property owners, when notified of their properties' water demand allocations, may, for a period of up to 30 days after the date of notification of their water demand allocations, purchase additional water demand at the non-residential rate in effect as of the date of this resolution.
