

## RESOLUTION NO. 757

### RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES RECOMMENDING THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA REVISE THE WATER DEMAND FEES

WHEREAS, the current water demand fees are based on an investment in additional capacity of approximately \$10 million; and

WHEREAS, the demand fees must be revised periodically to compensate for the increase in investment in additional capacity which is now approximately \$100 million; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Utilities finds that the recommended water demand fees are necessary for the purpose of meeting growth related capital costs within the existing service area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Public Utilities recommends that the City Council pass a resolution revising water demand fees as shown in attached amended Exhibit "A".
