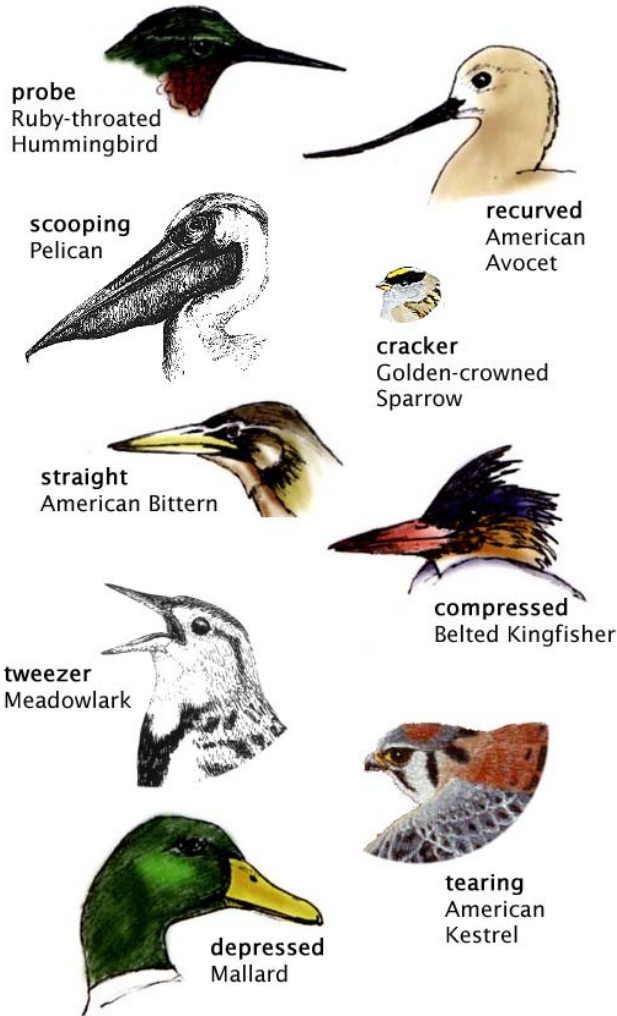


BIRD BEAKS

How many types can you find?

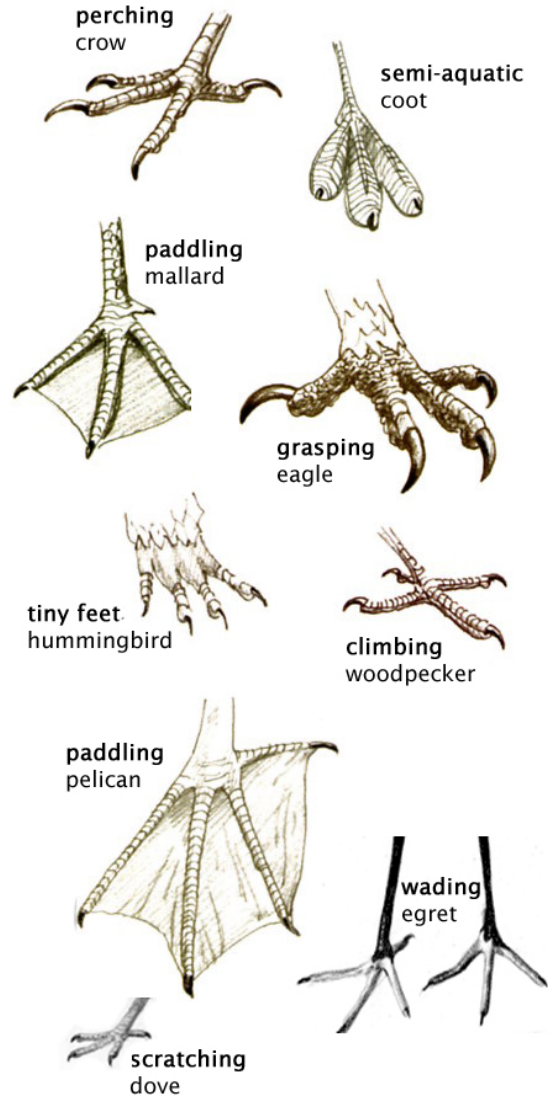
