Dear Research Team,

I live in the Burbank Gardens Historic Neighborhood and fought for historic status in 2003. I believe the historic neighborhoods surrounding Santa Rosa's Downtown is a very important element in looking at districts. What happens in the downtown area affects these historic districts. I believe an election district that recognizes the economic interests of the downtown in addition to the importance of surrounding historic neighborhoods is important. With that in mind, I am in favor of the draft maps that keep the most historic districts together.

Draft 114 combines a number of historic districts with the downtown area. The Burbank Gardens neighborhood, Juilliard Park neighborhood, Olive Park neighborhood, West End neighborhood, Railroad Square Historic and South Park were forever separated by highways 12 and 101. Combining these neighborhood under one election district makes sense -- again, what happens in the downtown/Railroad Square shopping district has effects on all surrounding neighborhoods, many of which are historic with particular interests and attributes.

Draft 121 and 101B are a far second, but are acceptable to me as they incorporate historic districts with DT and RRSQ.

Thank you for your hard work on this important issue to our community.
