 - Submit a copy of SONOMA COUNTY PERMIT AND RESOURCE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT (PRMD) ABANDONMENT OF WELL PERMIT and/or ABANDONMENT OF SEPTIC SYSTEM PERMIT.
- □ Work performed on State Of California owned property / rightof-way:
 - Submit a copy of CALTRANS ENCROACHMENT PERMIT.
- ☐ Work performed in channels, streams, or wetlands:
 - Submit a copy of STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH & GAME STREAMBED ALTERATION AGREEMENT.
- ☐ Excavation exceeding 5 feet in depth:
 - Submit a copy of STATE OF CALIFORNIA OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH AGENCY (CAL O.S.H.A.) PERMIT.



OBTAINING A GRADING PERMIT



Once a set of improvement plans have been signed and approved for construction by the City Engineer, the project will be ready to move forward to

construction. The applicant will need to submit a completed Grading Permit application to:

City of Santa Rosa Community Development-Engineering Division, Room 5, City Hall





ITEMS NEEDED WITH SUBMITTAL OF EACH APPLICATION:

GRADING PERMIT APPLICATION:

- Submit completed Grading Permit application

PLANS:

- Submit **3 black line sets** of the **approved (signed)** subdivision improvement plans

VALUATION OF WORK:

 Submit Engineer's Cost Estimate (Valuation) of work to be performed for fee calculation

FEES:

- Plan check fees, calculated by staff based on the valuation of the work to be performed, shall be submitted at the time of application

Note: Additional fees will be due and payable upon issuance of the permit



ITEMS WHICH MAY BE REQURIED PRIOR TO ISSUANCE OF GRADING PERMIT:

(PROJECT SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS)

☐ City encroachment permit:

- Submit a copy of CITY OF SANTA ROSA ENCROACHMENT PERMIT issued by the Department of Public Works for any work performed in City right-of-way

□ Notice of intent (N.O.I.):

- Submit a copy of letter from the STATE OF CALIFORNIA WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD indicating that they have received and processed your Notice of Intent (N.O. I.) to comply with the terms of the General Permit to Discharge Storm Water Associated with Construction Activity of projects that disturb one acre or more.

☐ Removal of existing structures not designated to remain:

- Submit a copy of CITY OF SANTA ROSA BUILDING DIVISION DEMOLITION PERMIT

☐ Exporting soil from site:

- Submit ESTIMATED QUANITY OF EXPORT IN CUBIC YARDS DISPOSAL SITE
- Submit copy of APPROVED CITY OR COUNTY PERMIT accepting the export of soil from site
- Submit copy of LETTER FROM SOILS ENGINEER approving soil to be placed at the disposal site
- Submit copy of HAUL ROUTE DIAGRAM for approval of export amounts in EXCESS OF 10,000 CUBIC YARDS.

☐ Retaining walls / sound walls:

- Submit a copy of the ISSUED BUILDING PERMIT for any retaining walls or sound walls.
