CityBus Adjusts Services for Essential Travel Fare-Free and Modified Level of Service

To further protect our drivers and passengers during the [Shelter in Place Order](#), Santa Rosa CityBus is operating fare-free service. This measure is meant to eliminate passenger interaction with fareboxes and reduce close contact between drivers and passengers. Additionally, passengers can enter and exit through the rear or front doors of the buses and are encouraged to practice social distancing by sitting at least six feet away from the drivers and each other.

CityBus is currently operating a modified level of service due to an anticipated reduction in ridership following the Shelter in Place Order. [View current schedule.](#)
