



Water Conserving Plumbing Fixture Self Verification Form

Dear Property Owner or licensed contractor:

Senate Bill 407 amended the California Civil Code, Sections 1101.1 through 1101.8, and established requirements relating to the replacement of noncompliant plumbing fixtures with water-conserving plumbing fixtures in single-family residential real properties built on or before January 1, 1994. As of January 1, 2014, SB 407 requires non-compliant plumbing fixtures to be replaced by water-conserving plumbing fixtures when a property is undergoing alterations or improvements. Construction related to repairs or maintenance of the structure is not considered to be an alteration or improvement.

Permitted repairs that will not trigger SB 407 include but are not limited to: Electrical service change out; HVAC change out; Water heater replacement; Re-roof; Window replacement; Sewer line replacement; Siding or stucco repair; Site work; other repairs as determined by the Building Official.

The residence proposed for alteration or improvement listed by the permit above was built prior to January 1, 1994, and the alterations or improvements proposed do require replacement of non-compliance plumbing fixtures.

By signing this document, the property owner or licensed contractor certifies to the City of Santa Rosa Building Division that all existing non-compliant plumbing fixtures identified below have been or will be replaced prior to final inspection on the above referenced project as specified by SB 407.

Non-compliant plumbing fixtures include the following fixtures:

- a. Water closets (toilets) that use more than an average of 1.6 gallons per flush
- b. Urinals that use more than an average of 1.0 gallons per flush
- c. Any shower head that has a flow capacity of more than 2.5 gallons per minute
- d. An interior faucet that emits more than 2.2 gallons per minute

This form is required to be completed and signed prior to a permit being issued. If an on-line permit is issued, prior to final inspection, this form must be signed and returned by mail to the City of Santa Rosa Building Division, 100 Santa Rosa Avenue, Room 3, Santa Rosa, CA 95404.
